



Main Street Incentive Grant

The Mineola Main Street Incentive Grant Program was developed in 1989 by the Main Street Board to help downtown merchants with small exterior renovations. Funds for this program are raised through the volunteer Main Street Advisory Board fundraising promotions. The City of Mineola does not receive any federal or state funds to promote or market Mineola.

Guidelines for Grant:

1. Grants will be administered on a need basis. Severe needs will take propriety over others until funds are depleted.
2. Grants will be given for a match up to \$1,000.00 for exterior renovations per building.
3. Only those who own buildings or businesses within the Main Street District are eligible to apply.
4. Board decisions are guided by the Texas Main Street Program.
5. Submit a letter of request to the Main Street Board of Advisors, along with a completed Incentive Grant Agreement form.
6. Include in this letter a detailed description of the finished work and invoices for the project.
7. The Main Street Advisory Board will not grant funds until the project is completed.

Note: Incentive grants were changed at the July 2011 board retreat.
